On an annual basis, the Navajo Nation spends about \$5.9 million on utilities encompassing electric, water, waste water, propane/natural gas, waste disposal and other utilities to governmental offices Navajo Nation wide.

#### RESOLUTION OF THE HEALTH, EDUCATION AND HUMAN SERVICE COMMITTEE

23rd NAVAJO NATION COUNCIL -- Third Year, 2017

#### AN ACTION

RELATING TO HEALTH, EDUCATION AND HUMAN SERVICES COMMITTEE; APPROVING AMENDMENTS TO THE NAVAJO NATION UTILITES SERVICE POLICIES AND PROCEDURES AS THEY APPLY TO THE NAVAJO NATION AND AS PROPOSED BY THE TELECOMMUNICATIONS AND UTILITIES DEPARTMENT WITHIN THE DIVISION OF GENERAL SERVICES

#### BE IT ENACTED:

#### SECTION ONE. AUTHORITY

A. The Health, Education and Human Services Committee of the Navajo Nation Council has legislative oversight of general government services and human services, hence the Division of General Services, including the authority to review, recommend or propose adoption of appropriate Plans of Operation. 2 N.N.C. §\$ 400 (C)(1), 401 (C)(1)

#### SECTION TWO. FINDINGS

- A. The Navajo Nation Telecommunications and Utilities Department (NNTU) within the Division of General Services provides access to essential telecommunications and utility service for the Navajo Nation government.
- B. The Navajo Nation Division of General Services, Telecommunications and Utilities Department has proposed amending the policies and procedures regarding utilities services as they apply to the Navajo Nation. See Exhibit "A".
- C. The proposed amendments to these policies and procedures have been reviewed by the necessary parties and found legally sufficient. See Exhibit "B".
- D. The Health, Education and Human Services Committee of the Navajo Nation Council finds it in the best interest of the Navajo Nation to approve the proposed amendments to the policies and procedures regarding utilities service as applied to the Navajo Nation as proposed by the Navajo Nation Division of General Services, Telecommunications and Utilities Department Plan of Operation as found at Exhibit "A".

# Utilities Service Policy & Procedures

#### **PURPOSE:**

- To provide a safe, comfortable and productive working environment of Navajo Nation government offices by ensuring use of quality utilities sources to sustain its operation
- To procure utilities service in the most cost effective manner and to promote energy & water conservation

# Utilities Service Policy & Procedures

### POLICY:

All Navajo Nation divisions, departments, and programs are to request for utilities and other related services through the NNTU department who shall procure those services on behalf of the Navajo Nation

# Type of Utilities Services Procured

### <u> Utilities:</u>

- Electricity
- > Natural gas
- Propane
- > Water
- > Wastewater

## Type of Utilities Services Procured

### Other Services:

- > Waste Disposal
- > Elevator Maintenance
- > Landscaping (if funds available)
- > HVAC system maintenance and repair (if funds available)
- Utilities hook up and line move (if funds available)

### Procedures

All utility and other services shall be requested through memorandum and completion of Utilities Service Request Form

All utility services shall be utilized in the performance of Navajo Nation government business and operations

#### **Utilities Service Process Flow Chart**

Customer will review Utilities Service Policy & Procedures. Customer will complete Utilities Request Form and submitted to NNTU.



NNTU will review request for completeness including business unit number.



If incomplete, NNTU will notify Customer for resolution. If no response after one week, NNTU will return request to Customer.



NNTU will coordinate with the applicable service provider by completing and submitting required forms and documents.



If construction is required, NNTU will coordinate with Customer on payment to service provider once cost estimate is provided.



If insufficient funds, request will be returned to Customer for resolution.



Upon payment, service provider will complete request.



If no construction is required, NNTU receives monthly billing and processes payment.

### Billing and Payment

NNTU will be responsible for payment processing of utilities services invoices. All bills will be invoiced directly to NNTU.

NNTU receives an annual funding under the Fixed Cost-Utilities account. All requests for use of these funds require pre-approved by NNTU (subject to availability of funds).



### Billing and Payment

Due to anticipated FY2020 Budget Cuts for General Fund, NNTU will be assessing current accounts to determine if we will continue fund those accounts. If not, departments will need to budget for monthly reoccurring costs.



# Department and Employee Responsibility



- Practice and promote energy and water conservation in the workplace
- Report the misuse and abuse of utilities by Navajo Nation governmental personnel to NNTU
- Prohibit use of unnecessary appliances in the workplace

# Department and Employee Responsibility



- Immediately report utility outages and breakages to utility service provider and/or NNTU
- Purchase energy efficient office equipment with the EnergyStar logo.
